About Bharathiar University

The Bharathiar University was established at Coimbatore at the foothills of Maruthamalai in the Western Ghats by the Government of Tamil Nadu in February 1982. Our students have the opportunity to get rich hands-on-experience and training from the facilities available in the Department of Diagnostic Radiology, Nuclear Medicine and Radiotherapy at GKNM Hospital.

They are also exposed to field training in various cancer hospitals all over India. Almost all our students who completed their M.Sc Medical Physics programme are employed as Medical Physicists and Radiation Safety Officers in cancer hospitals throughout the country. Also, some of our outstanding students are working in World Health Organization (WHO) and few of them are pursuing research programme in USA and other developed countries.
